



Ms. Hurtado was appointed Assistant City Manager for the City of Hayward, California in Nov 2016. Prior to this appointment Ms. Hurtado served as the Assistant City Manger of Oxnard, California and was the Interim City Manager in Tracy, California previously. In this capacity, she was responsible for all of the daily operations of the City, Council and Community Relations, and Strategic Planning and Visioning. For seven years prior to her interim appointment, her leadership skills were showcased as Tracy's Assistant City Manager. In this capacity, she served as the Chief Operating Officer (COO) responsible for special projects and the daily operations of four operating departments, including Development Services and Economic Development, Fire, Parks and Community Services, and Public Works Department. Ms. Hurtado also oversaw the City Clerk's Office and the Mayor's Community Youth Support Network program.

Ms. Hurtado was hired to the City of Tracy as the Director of Parks and Community Services before being appointed Assistant City Manager in 2007. Prior to this position, Ms. Hurtado served as Deputy Director of Parks & Neighborhood Services for the City of San Jose, and Assistant Director for Parks and Community Services and Assistant Director of Redevelopment and Housing for the City of Watsonville, California.
